 - 2. What is sin?(1 John 3:4; James 4:17).
 - 3. What does sin do in our lives? What are its consequences?

 - c. The wrath of judgment(2 Thess. 1:7-9).
 - d. Eternity in Hell(Mark 9:47-49).

 - 1. Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:8, 10.
 - 2. The Jews had a bad attitude toward their sin(John 8:31-39).

 - 4. The Spirit tells not only of sin, but what to do about it.
