- A. OUR TEXTS REFER TO THE EXALTATION OF THE REJECTED CHRIST.
 - Marvelous, thaumastos, "wonderful, ... worthy of pious admiration ... passing 1 human comprehension ... extraordinary" - Thayer.
 - Much of what God has done is Wonderful and passes our ability to comprehend. 2.

THE INVENTIONS OF MEN MIGHT BE SAID TO BE MARVELOUS. B.

- Computer technology. 1.
- 2. The St. Louis Arch, built from both ends meeting perfectly in the middle.
- 3. Man on the moon is a small thing – but a marvelous thing.
- ALL OF MAN'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS PALE NEXT TO WHAT GOD HAS DONE. C.
 - Consider the creation of one day (Psa. 118:24). More to it than the sun coming up. 1.
 - 2. Consider the plan of salvation and all that opposed it.
 - 3. What accomplishment of man comes close?
- D. Isa. 12:4-6. WE ARE TOLD TO "DECLARE HIS DOINGS" (Psa. 66:5; 77:12).

WHAT ARE THE DOINGS OF GOD?

HE MADE THE WORLD. <u>I.</u>

- "IN THE BEGINNING ..."(Gen. 1:1; Heb. 11:3). A.
- B. HE NOT ONLY MADE IT, BUT HE CONTROLS IT (Acts 17:24-28).
- IT IS HIS PARTICULAR HANDIWORK (Psa. 19:1; Rom. 1:21). C.

Psalm 33:9

For he spake, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.

HE MADE MAN (Psa. 139:13-16; Job 10:8-12). II.

- MAN WAS MADE FROM THE LOWEST ELEMENT (Gen. 2:7). A.
- BUT HE WAS MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE (Gen. 1:26; Acts 17:28-29). B.
- MAN'S SMALLNESS AND GOD'S FAVOR RAISES A QUESTION (Psa. 8:3-9). C.
- IT BEHOVES US TO SEEK OUT AND FULFILL OUR PURPOSE (Ecc. 12:13-14). D.

IV. HE GAVE US THE BIBLE (1 Thess. 2:13).

- A. THE SCRIPTURES ARE INSPIRED OF GOD (2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Pet. 1:20-21).
- B. THE **PROCESS** OF INSPIRATION IS DESCRIBED (1 Cor. 2:10-13).
- C. THE OUTCOME IS THAT WE HAVE THE MIND OF CHRIST (1 Cor. 2:16).
 - Jude 3. There is no need for latter day revelation (2 Pet. 1:3; 2 Tim. 3:16-17). 1.
 - 2. Our understanding is made possible by our reading (Eph. 3:3-4).
 - It is *sinful* to go beyond that which is written (1 Cor. 4:6; 2 John 9). 3.

HE GAVE US THE CHURCH (Eph. 3:21). <u>V.</u> A.

- ALL THE FORCES OF SATAN WERE THROWN UP AGAINST IT.
 - Described as War in Heaven (Rev. 12:7-10). 1.
 - 2. Jesus was killed but Hades couldn't hold him (Act 2:22-24).
 - Death could not stop him from building the church (Matt. 16:18). 3.
- GOD'S WISDOM MADE KNOW THROUGH THE CHURCH (Eph. 3:10-11). B.
- С. IN THE CHURCH IS THE FULNESS OF CHRIST (Eph. 1:22-23).
- IT IS PRECIOUS TO HIM (Acts 20:28; Eph. 5:25-27). D.
- E. ACCEPT NO SUBSTITUTES! (Psa. 127:1; Matt. 15:13).

VI. HE GAVE US THE CROSS OF CHRIST (Gal. 6:14; 1 Cor. 1:18).

- A. REMEMBER THAT MAN IS SPECIAL TO GOD (Gen. 1:26; Acts 17:28-29).
- B. BUT MAN HAS SINNED (Rom. 3:23 è 6:23). The wages of sin is death!
- C. GOD WANTS ALL TO BE SAVED (2 Pet. 3:9), BUT JUSTICE DEMANDS DEATH!
- D. THE CROSS, WHERE LOVE AND JUSTICE MEET (Rom. 3:23-26).
 - 1. Justified by the redemption in Christ's blood.
 - 2. Why? To show God's righteousness in justifying the guilty (vs. 26-27).
- E. WHAT MUST I DO TO SHARE WITH JESUS IN HIS DEATH? (Rom. 6:3-4, 7).

I MUST BE BAPTIZED INTO CHRIST!
