SHOULD WE FOLLOW THE BIBLE ALONE? Or

RELATED QUESTION - WHERE DOES OUR AUTHORITY COME FROM?

What does the Bible say?

TEXT: 1 Corinthians 4:6

Context deeply divided church and the solution was sticking to what was written.

There is a deep division TODAY among those who call themselves Christians.

Several reasons for that but answering this question could go a long way to solving this issue.

Now Examining this question we need to realize:

- 1. No Single Passage of Scripture specifically says it this way
 - A. Why is that?
 - 1. Because Apostles were still alive & able to speak & Wrote most of the NT
 - 2. Scripture wasn't complete until the 1st Century
 - B. HOWEVER THE SCRIPTURES POINT TO A **TIME** WHEN **THEY ALONE** SHOULD BE RELIED ON FOR AUTHORITY
 - C. BRINGS UP THE NEED TO EXAMINE THE PROCESS OF REVELATION AND THE CLAIM OF **ALL-SUFFICIENCY** OF THE SCRIPTURES.

Let's Look at the Process of Revelation

I. PROCESS OF REVELATION THRU INSPIRATION

- A. Jesus is God's Spokesman for Today Hebrews 1:1-2
 - 1. He is the **mediator** of a **New Covenant Hebrews 9:15-17**
 - 2. Foretold by Moses (Deut. 18:15-19); Acts 3:20, 22-23
 - 3. Salvation in Jesus Name Only Acts 4:10-12, (John 14:6)
 - 4. Jesus Word is the Standard John 12:48

HOWEVER

- B. Jesus Doesn't Speak to Us Directly Today
 - 1. He selected 12 men to be his ambassadors Mark 3:14-15; JOHN 17:20
 - 2. He promised them the Holy Spirit who would direct them in their speech.
 - a. He would remind them of what Jesus had already said **John 14:26**
 - 3. This promise was made only to the apostles John 15:26-27 (Luke 22:14)
- C. Were Others Involved? **Ephesians 3:3-5**

THE WILL OF JESUS WAS REVEALED THRU THE APOSTLES & PROPHETS BUT WHAT ABOUT IN MATTERS OF AUTHORITY

- D. Possession of Holy Spirit is DEFINITE Factor in Matter of Authority
 - God's law delivered by them because God was speaking through them Luke 10:16
 - 2. God demonstrated his approval through miracles Heb. 2:3-4
 - 3. Today, No One
 - a. Can work miracles as they did.
 - b. Is inspired of the Holy Spirit.
 - c. Has the authority to reveal God's will.
 - 4. Why can't the apostles pass on the power of prophecy today?

There Are No Apostles Today!

a. Bestowers of gifts - Acts 8:18, Romans 10:17

NOW AS FAR AS AUTHORITY...LET'S REVIEW WHAT WE READ:

- E. Apostolic Authority Well Established & Confirmed
- Jesus specifically choose the Apostles for this task
- Holy Spirit led them by Jesus Authority
- They alone had ability to pass on the power of the Holy Spirit

HOWEVER, SOME CLAIM THE CHURCH HAS AUTHORITY TO GIVE LAW

- 1. NO SCRIPTURE FOR IT
- 2. Jesus is the head of the church has ALL AUTHORITY Matt 28:18; Eph. 1:22-23
- 3. He speaks through the apostles and prophets of the New Testament

 Matt. 18:18 GAVE KEYS TO THE APOSTLES

 Luke 10:16 THOSE THAT HEAR THEM HEAR JESUS

NOW THAT WE HAVE ESTABLISHED THAT JESUS SPEAKS THROUGH THE APOSTLES PRIMARILY AND THEY ARE SPOKEMEN FOR JESUS.....let's look at the

3 DIFFERENCE STAGES OF INSPIRATION

II. 3 DIFFERENCE STAGES OF INSPIRATION

- A. TIME When Just ORAL WORD OF MOUTH OF INSPIRED MEN.
 - 1. Referenced in the NT Acts 2; 8:1 & 4; etc.

 When 1st happened wasn't Recorded in writing.
 - a. 1st written book of NT was about 20 years after this happened

B. TIME WHEN BOTH ORAL AND WRITTEN

- 1. Traditions equated with gospel given by verbal word or epistle 2 Thess. 2:15
- 2. Words spoken by prophets & commandments of Apostles 2 Pet. 3:1-2 -
- 3. Passages do not teach that the oral and written traditions were independent of each other. **They Agree!**
 - a They Do Not teach continued oral inspiration through the ages.
 - b. They merely confirm the authority in the writings and the words of the Apostles.

C. <u>TIME WHEN SCRIPTURES ANTICIPATE Sola Scriptura</u>.

- 1. The Scripture's claim
 - a. 2 Tim. 3:16-17 ABOUT RIGHTEOUSNESS & CAN DO EVERY GOOD WORK (ABOUT WHAT RIGHT AND GOD'S WORK)
 - b. 2 Peter 1:3 ALL THINGS THAT PERTAIN TO LIFE & GODLINESS

 (ABOUT SALVATION, KNOWING & LIVING THE WAY GOD WANTS US TO)

 thru knowledge of Jesus
 - c. Where do we know anything about Jesus?

 John 21:24
- 2. OT Predicted & NT confirms The End of Prophecy! Zech. 13:1-2; 1 Cor. 13:8-10
- 3. Jude's claim Jude 3 → Heb. 10:10

- A. THE SCRIPTURES AND THEIR TEACHINGS HAVE BEEN CONFIRMED.
 - 1. The things written were commanded
 - 2 Thess. 3:4, 1 Tim. 3:14-15; 4:6, 11;
 - 2. They have authority Titus 2:15
 - a. Commanded of the Lord 1 Cor. 14:37
 - 3. They have purpose 2 Tim. 3:16-17
- B. FAITH WAS ONCE DELIVERED Jude 3
- C. WE WILL BE JUDGED OUT OF THE BOOKS WRITINGS Rev. 20:12
- D. WARNED AGAINST DEVIATING
 - 1. Loss of fellowship 2 John 9
 - 2. AND SO ... 1 Cor. 4:6 NOT TO GO BEYOND WHAT? THAT WHICH IS WRITTEN
