- C. WHILE HIDING, HE WAS DOING NOTHING FOR THE LORD.

II. "WHAT DOEST THOU HERE?"

- A. OF ALL PEOPLE, ELIJAH SHOULD HAVE KNOWN BETTER.
- B. WE SHOULD KNOW BETTER THAN TO BE DISCOURAGED AND HIDE.
 - 1. We have God's promise(**2 Tim. 2:11-13**).
 - 2. We have seen him deliver(**Rom. 15:4**).
 - 3. **Romans 8:31f.**

III. ELIJAH WAS GIVEN A MISSION(vs. 15-16).

- A. WE ALSO HAVE A MISSION(**Matt. 28:19-20**).
- B. WE CAN DO NOTHING WHILE HIDING IN OUR CAVE OF DESPONDENCY.
