 - 1. "I am"(**Ex. 3:14**; **John 8:58**).
 - 2. "The first and the last"(**Isa. 44:6**; **Rev. 1:17**).
 - 3. "Alpha & Omega"(Rev. 1:8; 22:13).
- C. JESUS WAS AT THE CREATION(John 1:1-3; Heb. 1:1-2).
 - 1. Jesus was "first-born" of Creation(Col. 1:15).
 - 2. Also of the dead(vs. 18).
 - 3. "First-born" defined(Psa. 89:27; Rev. 1:5; John 5:26-29).
 - 4. Doesn't always refer to "born first" (Jer. 31:9; Gen. 41:51-52; 48:19).
 - 5. Context explains usage(Col. 1:15-18).
- D. JESUS IS TO BE WORSHIPED

(Mat. 28:9, 17; Heb. 1:6; Mat 4:10; Rev. 22:8-9).

- E. DOES NOT MEAN "SAME PERSON" "SAME ESSENCE" (Col. 2:9).
 - 1. **Vine**, "theotes indicates the divine essence of Godhood, the personality of God."
 - 2. **A&G**, "Deity, divinity."
 - 3. **Phil. 2:6**. "*morphe* means the essential attributes as shown in the form. In his preincarnate state, Christ possessed the attributes of God and so appeared to those in Heaven who saw him." **A. T. Robertson**
 - 4. Heb. 1:2-3.
